Jamie Maule-ffinch is a British writer/director with a masters in stupidity. Since a young age he has wanted to make people laugh and now he earns money by creating films that do just that.

Having a decade of directing experience under his belt Jamie has shot all around the world for many prestigious brands. He has won a D&AD Yellow Pencil as well as best comedy for his short film *Morning After* in the 2017 Discover Film awards. His web series *Tits Up* was nominated for a string of awards including best comedy series at Austin Comedy Shorts Festival 2018. He is currently developing a sitcom as well as feature film projects.

His commercial style takes from the cinematic Gods of the 70s and 80s making images that are modern but with a classic twist. He loves to use long tracking shots to route the audience within the scene and reveal key comic moments. Casting strange but loveable characters is key to Jamie's aesthetic. He works extensively with the actors to bring about memorable performances and often uses his skills of improvisation to capture a variety of different takes.

Jamie also has extensive experience in working with children - he puts it down to the fact that in essence he is just a massive child at heart.
